What is a literature review (LR)?

 A discussion on information in a particular subject area significant to your research

In what way is a LR different from an academic research paper?

	Academic research paper	Literature review
Focus	To develop a new argument	To discuss arguments and ideas of others
Function	To present a research work	To act as a foundation and support for a new insight you contribute



Why do we write literature reviews?

- To provide background information
- To establish importance
- To demonstrate familiarity
- To "carve out a space" for further research



Steps For Writing a Literature Review

- Planning
- Reading and Research
- Analyzing
- Drafting
- Revising



Planning

- Clarify purpose
- Find models
- Narrow your topic
- Consider whether your sources are current



Reading and Research

- Find a focus
- Construct a working thesis statement
- Consider organization



Organization

- Cover the basic categories:
 - Introduction
 - Body
 - Conclusion

- Organize the body
 - Chronological (by publication or by trend)
 - Thematic
 - Methodological



Organization, cont'd

- Additional sections may be necessary
 - State of the Art
 - History

- Methods and/or standards
- Questions for further research



Analyzing

- Summarize recap
- Synthesize rephrase and relate
- Compare
- Critique



Drafting

- Use evidence to back up interpretation
- Be selective
- Use quotes sparingly
- Keep your own voice
- Use caution when paraphrasing



Revising

- Spend time revising
 - Check to make sure your review meets its objective
 - Rewrite/rework the language to present information in a concise manner
 - Use terminology familiar to your audience
 - Use APA style to document your sources and format your review



Other issues

- Jargons/slangs
- Abbreviations
- Sentences
- Passive voice
- Punctuation and grammar
- Repeated ideas
- Bibliography
- Supervisor



Other issues, cont'd

- Tables and figures
- Headings
- Sources
- Research gaps
- Writing
- Language
